- 6 down at the bottom of the first page under
- 7 "Considerations." And you're talking there about it
- 8 being necessary to bring the funding within normal
- 9 program maximum assistance levels. And I assume by that
- 10 you were talking about equity and that sort of thing?
- 11 A. Yeah.
- 12 Q. And then you make the sentence, "In subsequent
- telephone conversations that day, Westray was apparently
- 14 successful in convincing the Province of Nova Scotia,
- specifically Premier Buchanan, to assist the project.
- 16 Westray has stated that the Province will now buy one
- 17 million tonnes of coal from the new mine..." et cetera,
- 18 et cetera. Was this where the take-or-pay agreement came
- from or what specifically did you understand had been the
- 20 commitment by the Province?
- 21 A. [No audible response]
- 22 O. Or perhaps it --
- 23 A. I think it's -- I think --
- 0. -- was the subordinated loan.
- 25 A. I think it's both. The take-or-pay first came to
