2 COMMISSIONER Good morning. Now, Mr. Rogers, I was
3 reminded this morning that you are not a Provincial
4 witness, so Mr. Traves doesn't feel that he should lead
5 off and I agree with that. So I'll pass to Mr. Campbell
6 at this time. And I presume you would want to, as with
7 the previous Federal witness, you'd want to come back in
8 case anything arises during the other cross?

9 MR. COLIN CAMPBELL Yes, sir.
