- 1 Q. You were told that at the meeting or --
- A. At the meeting.
- 3 Q. Did you understand anything more about his role as a
- 4 consultant and did you understand, for example, whether
- 5 or not he was being paid as a consultant?
- 6 A. No. I assume he was, but I don't know what his role
- 7 was.
- 8 Q. He was a Member of Parliament at this time?
- 9 A. I don't think so.
- 10 Q. Oh, he re --
- 11 A. Yes.
- 12 O. He did -- he had left Parliament?
- 13 A. He left Parliament.
- 14 Q. You said he left the Government, but --
- 15 A. Yes.
- 16 O. -- in fact, he left Parliament?
- 17 A. Yes.
- 18 Q. Okay, fair enough. And the meeting in October of
- 19 1988 where his name appears as being present at your
- offices in Ottawa, do you recall anything of his
- involvement in that meeting?
- 22 A. I don't think he ever said a word.
- Q. He is listed in that meeting as attending on behalf
- of the Government, or at least being a part of a
- 25 government delegation, along with Mr. MacKay, "Government
