MR. ROGERS, EXAM. BY MR. TRAVES

- 1 provides in Section 3, "That payments on account of the
- 2 contribution shall be made no more frequently than
- 3 quarterly and shall be made on the basis of written
- 4 claims for payment submitted." That it appears to me
- 5 that this is a contract which puts forward that the
- 6 Government will make contributions, i.e., payments, over
- 7 a regular period of time on the basis of submitted
- 8 documentation including written reports and relevant
- 9 supporting documentation.
- 10 A. Well, that was done. It's a very straightforward
- 11 procedure. It's an accounting procedure primarily,
- 12 whereby you have a certification on the amount of the
- outstanding loan, a computation of the interest cost, a
- 14 computation of what the share is to be paid in accordance
- 15 with this agreement. And to the extent required, those
- 16 were the monthly monitoring reports done for the bank,
- 17 that would be the documentation that supported it.
- 18 Q. So the Government was satisfied that the applicant
- in this case was proceeding diligently with the project?
- 20 A. The evidence would say -- suggest that, yes.
- 21 Q. Yes. And you're not aware at any point of Mr.
- 22 Sherwood or CANMET suggesting that a mine plan was
- 23 required in order to ensure that this was taking place?
- 24 A. No.
- 25 O. No. They didn't require that?
