- 1 file to be transferred there and that Mr. Rogers, who is
- 2 responsible for the Department that finally made the
- 3 deal, certainly didn't indicate that, I don't believe.
- 4 So that wouldn't be my understanding.
- 5 O. All right. What was your understanding?
- 6 A. My understanding, that we were dealing with the
- 7 Department of Industry -- or -- and a number of people in
- 8 that Department.
- 9 Q. Can you describe for me what you understood to have
- 10 been the role that the Prime Minister or the P.M.O. took
- in relation to assisting in getting the package put
- 12 together?
- 13 A. I don't think it would be unreasonable to --
- 14 especially the fact that he, at one time, was Member for
- the area, that he would be interested in this. I guess
- 16 it's much like that comment I read to you yesterday, in
- 17 the paper last Saturday, where the current Premier of the
- 18 Province of Nova Scotia said, "I called the Prime
- 19 Minister twice on the issue of DEVCO." This is the usual
- 20 practice. There's nothing nasty or illegal or strange
- 21 about those kind of calls and -- so I would see his role
- 22 the same way the current Prime Minister will get calls
- from his Members, the Members in the area, Premier of the
- 24 Province, all over Canada, for certain projects. I would
- 25 see this in the same light.
