1 coal from the strip mine, the Foord seam, to burn in
2 Trenton 6? And that they're -- they join -- they have a
3 joint venture with a private company to again look for
4 methane to use in Trenton to take care of this problem.

5 And, in fact, DEVCO would have lost jobs in that
6 issue because in order to take enough of that good coal
7 that was easy for them to sell off the world market, they
8 would lose jobs. Because they were saying, "Well, we
9 will lose those contracts and do this for you," but they

12 already selling. It was -- the hard coal to sell was the
13 coal from Prince, the thermal coal. This was the very
14 best coal, it was the easiest coal to sell. So it would
15 have been a job lost for DEVCO too, which I couldn't
16 understand.

17 Q. I appreciate that by background. My question was:
18 Did you make that threat to them?

19 A. That we change the sulphur?
