1 Corporation that they will tell you they had plant-by-
2 plant rules. And what I was trying to tell them was

13 have there now. Why would we have to change them, Mr.
14 Merrick?

15 Q. We know from Mr. Rogers, and from subsequent
16 correspondence, that he then raised this issue in
17 correspondence as to whether that could be done. In
18 fact, I think he also wrote another letter to you asking
19 for a commitment that it would not be done. The
20 implication being that there must have been such a threat
21 made. Are you able to refute that such a threat was
22 made?

23 A. I don't know what he took out of the conversation.
24 All I can say is that there's a plant-by-plant rule for
25 Nova Scotia Power, and we couldn't meet it with his
