- and we believe there's additional coal in the County,
- 2 maybe not, but we -- that would be the last part we'll
- 3 mine on the way out."
- 4 O. And that was at the very beginning of this --
- 5 A. At the --
- 6 Q. -- project?
- 7 A. -- very start, yeah. It was a big, big plan we
- 8 looked at.
- 9 Q. Did you ever have any discussions with him
- 10 subsequently about their -- the fact that they had
- changed their minds, or that they were going into the
- 12 Southwest?
- 13 A. Not when they did. I mean, sometime, you know, I
- 14 learned that they were going to mine coal there. He said
- they were going to produce coal there and continue to --
- 16 on the original plan to. I had discussions when -- keep
- 17 hearing about these roof falls, I certainly had had
- 18 concerns then. Like any other person that heard about
- them, you'd be concerned. So, you know, I began then to
- 20 worry about the Southwest section.
- 21 O. Did you ever have any discussions with him in which
- 22 he discussed with you the point you made yesterday, that
- 23 they went into the Southwest because of -- they were
- 24 under pressure to do so?
