- Q. Other than that visit, can you give me any
- 3 approximation as to the number of times you would have

- 6 A. I really don't know.
- 7 Q. Would it have been several times? Maybe six, seven?
- 8 Maybe 15?
- 9 A. I really don't know. I really can't estimate.
- 10 Q. You can't quantify that --
- 11 A. But I was on the premises when they -- when it was
- 12 under construction; I went there lots of times. But by
- the time I got to, you know, '91, I became Premier in
- 14 February 26, '91. I think you'd realize that you have
- quite a busy schedule and you don't get home every
- 16 weekend. And when you are home you have books and books
- 17 and books to read, so I didn't really have a whole lot of
- 18 free time after '91.
- 19 Q. Were you aware that the Department of Natural
- 20 Resources was having some difficulty to keep them
- 21 informed as to changes that were taking place?
- 22 A. No, I was not.
- 23 Q. Was anybody communicating with you as to what the
- 24 Department of Natural Resources was doing in its
- 25 monitoring of this mine?
