- 1 Premier and nothing was done, yes.
- Q. I'm talking about if in hindsight it is determined

- 7 A. And -- yes. But the information has to go up the

- step forward and say, "I accept that responsibility"?
- 17 A. Well, I -- he has to accept part of what goes on in

- 22 that?
- 23 A. And if the Minister was informed about things going
- on in the Department, someone not doing their job, yes,
