- 7 indicated to the local people that there would be a mine

- 10 A. Well, I don't know who made the announcement or
- 11 what, but I mean, I think it's pretty reasonable to
- 12 expect if you're going to have a coal company come in,
- 13 you have to give them access to coal.
- 14 Q. Yes, yes.
- 15 A. That's what -- the business they're in.
- 16 O. Yes, but there's a lot of coal here. Some of it is
- 17 close to the surface and some of it is very deep.
- 18 A. Uh-huh.
