MR. CAMERON, EXAM. BY MR. WELLS

- 1 right?
- 2 A. That's right. And also, too, that it's the right of
- 3 the employee even to take part in developing that climate
- 4 of safety. The legislation makes clear that that's their
- 5 right to do that. That the employee -- employer just
- 6 can't say, "Well, I think it's safe and that's it,"
- 7 that's there a role for the employee to make sure that
- 8 it's going to be a safe work environment.
- 9 A. Thank you. I'm agreeing with you for a change. And
- 10 I would like to take that a little bit further in that
- when that right is violated, if he is not allowed to
- 12 participate or if he is intimidated, as we have been
- told, should not the Province at that point use their
- authority on that employer to bring that employer in
- 15 line?
- 16 A. Yes, and my understanding is the new Act that Mr.
- 17 Brown introduced in fact addresses some of those issues
- 18 and gives an employee more -- makes it clearer and gives
- 19 the employee more clout to make these kinds of decisions.
- 20 So, clearly, I think we're going in the right direction.
- 21 Q. But I'm not -- I guess I'm editorializing now, but
- 22 I'm not sure that the Department of Labour, that the
- 23 Government of the day has taken it on that they are going
- to see that that happens. It's still in the employee's
- 25 responsibility that he has to initiate it. And I feel
