- 7 the effect that that is not done, so what's my friend
- 8 getting at?
- 9 MR. HEBERT Well, there we have the evidence from your
- 10 counsel that, in fact, the evidence was it wasn't being
- 11 done. Does that surprise you?
- 12 MR. ENDRES It's not being done because it's not
- 13 required to be done.
- 14 MR. HEBERT Well, I asked --
- 15 MR. ENDRES Does that surprise you?
