- 1 Q. Now each one of the those individuals that I just
- listed to you, sir, was either a miner, a supervisor or
- 3 an overman.
- 4 A. Uh-huh.
- 5 O. And each one of them testified under oath here that
- 6 they never used the reset button and they never saw
- 7 anyone else use the reset button to cut coal in that
- 8 mine.
- 9 A. Uh-huh.
- 10 Q. Now you're not saying that they didn't tell the
- 11 truth under oath, are you?
- 12 A. No, I'm not -- I'm not passing judgement on them at
- 13 all. But could I make a comment about that,
- 14 Commissioner?
- 15 MR. ROBERTS I would rather you just answered the
- 16 question and --
- 17 A. Well, this is --
- 18 Q. -- and we go on.
- 19 A. -- this is an important issue.
- 20 <u>COMMISSIONER</u> Okay. Okay, well, go ahead, Mr. Cameron.
- 21 A. Well, it's a very important issue and this is the
- 22 interview that the Inquiry did with Mick Franks and
- 23 Harvey Martin.
- 24 <u>COMMISSIONER</u> Okay, that's in evidence.
